(a) Initiative: East Tennessee Radio Group Job Fair

The East Tennessee Radio Group held a job fair from 08:30am until 10:30am on Thursday March 14th 2024 at the Radio station location at 196 west Dumplin Valley road, Kodak TN 37764. The event was advertised on air on both WSEV 105.5 Fm and WPFT 106.3 Fm. Steve Hartford provided information regarding employment opportunities and accepted applications.
